Nurse Case Management is a specialized area of nursing practice that is focused on coordinating and optimizing patient care across the health care continuum.

Nurse Case Managers at Community Health Connections play a critical role in ensuring patients - particularly those with complex medical, behavioral health or social needs - receive comprehensive services and efficient patient-centered care.

At community health centers, this role is especially valuable, as Nurse Case Managers help bridge gaps between clinical services, social supports and community resources.

At Community Health Connections our Nurse Case Managers advocate for patients and facilitate communications among different care teams, which contributes to improved health outcomes, reduces hospitalizations and improves equitable access to health care.

Nurse Case Management Services and support include the following:

One-on-one patient visits and care coordination:

- Comprehensive Patient Assessments
- Individual Patient Care Plans
 - Develops patient care plans in collaboration with the patients, families and interdisciplinary teams.
- Coordination of Health Care Services across CHC providers, including primary care, behavioral health, dental, psychiatry, specialty care such as podiatry, optometry, nutritional counseling, weight management, diabetes education, along with outside referrals to community-based organizations.
- Provides patient education on disease management, medications and preventative care
- Monitors patient progress and adjusts care plans to ensure optimal outcomes.
- Facilitates transitions of care, such as hospital discharges and follow-up referrals.
Identifies barriers to care and connects patients with appropriate resources.
- Maintains accurate documentation to ensure compliance with regulatory and organizational standards.
